NMHS Health Plan Pharmacy Benefit Changes

Effective January 1, 2018, North Mississippi Health Benefit Plan contracted with WellDyneRX to provide pharmacy benefit manager services.

As part of the transition the Health Plan adopted the WellDyneRx Open Formulary. The NMHS Employee Pharmacy team has already begun to assist providers and patients in adjusting to the new formulary, including transitioning to alternative medications that provide the same clinical benefit and greater affordability for the member and the Health Plan. The Health Plan chose to defer some of the changes until May 1, 2018 in order to give you an opportunity to meet with the member to adjust the medication. Within the next several weeks, approximately 950 members will receive written notifications of the changes.
